5.3 CAO 56-2019 Strategic Plan Annual Report and 2020 Council Priorities Review

Brent Kittmer spoke to CAO 56-2019 report and responded to questions from the Committee.

Due to a lack of time, the Committee only briefly discussed 2020 priorities, 2020 budget target, end of term priorities, and items to remove from the work plan.

Key points included:

- Council's preferred budget target ranges from 2.0% 2.9%, with an acknowledgement that 2020 can be used as a year to buffer future cost increases associated with downloads.
- The hospital parking review to determine if the Town can prevent a fee being charged is no longer a priority.
- Priorities for 2020 include reconstruction of Elizabeth and Waterloo Streets to resolve basement flooding issues, delivering serviced industrial land, resolving Meadowridge entrance sign encroachment issue, and research into how the Town can incentivize small business to locate in St. Marys
