PURPOSE

To provide information to the Heritage Committee for their consideration in review of an application for a sign permit at 127 Queen St E.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

The property at 127 Queen St E is located in the Heritage Conservation District (HCD) and as such is a Part V property under the Ontario Heritage Act. The building does not have a Part IV designation under the Ontario Heritage Act.

The property at 127 Queen St E is the site of a retail pet store, and is situated between Water St N and Wellington St N.

REPORT

The town has received a sign application for a new façade sign. The new proposed location is directly above the windows and door. Based on the makeup of the façade, this would be considered the sign board area. The new proposed sogn is made of an aluminum composite material. The background color is proposed to be grey with black vinyl lettering. The size of the proposed sign is 10'long x2'high x1/4" thick.
